

HOSTEL FACILITY

Separate boys and girls hostel facilities with all basic amenities are available for limited number of students. There is advantage in staying at hostel because of the time they are going to spend with their friends in the academic atmosphere under proper supervision of qualified warden. Staying at the hostel not only teaches them the leadership quality but also widens his outlook towards the society. Besides regular warden, special teachers are also engaged to give them extra push they need to conquer the mental distraction. We have regular visitors from different walks of life to interact with our students to boost their confidence level. With constant supervision under the Administrator, we are providing the best facilities and service required for his studies, moral development, teamwork, leadership qualities and other extra-curricular activities.

Eligibility: Class III or 8 years of age whichever is less. If he/she has a brother or sister of higher class residing in the Hostel, the age and class can be relaxed.

Facility:

1. Regular Deeniyath/Moral & Arabic class after school
2. Extra Memory skills and MindMap classes
3. Reading and playing under strict supervision of the Warden
4. 5 times Namaz (Salah) for Muslim students.
5. Proper and hygienic balanced meal and breakfast
6. Basic etiquettes of Sleeping/Driving/Eating/Walking and social like communal harmony.
7. Library accessibility
8. Newspaper
9. Internet browsing (limited to educational websites and emailing)
10. Last Sunday meeting
11. Strictly supervised by CCTV camera

Mess: One of the best balanced meals is provided in the hostel.

Breakfast: Milk, Bread, Egg, Fruit Jam, Banana, Egg, Noodles, Omlet, Halwa, Puri-Sabji etc.

Meals : Non-Veg (Chicken, Egg, Fish) & Vegetables, Rice, Sweet dish, Dal, Salad, Papad,

Tea break: Red tea with cookies, bread, dry cake etc.

Uniform: Separate uniform is maintained for hostellers.

Boys: Tracksuit, Dark Navy blue shirt and trousers for normal days. Separate night dress. White Thobe with maroon detailing specially for Friday(Juma) prayer.

Girls: Black Thobe with white detailing, Tracksuit, Night dress

Holiday: During holiday, Hostel is closed and parents need to come to take them home safely. They need to return back as and when they are called for.

Visitors Day: Last Sunday of the month is visitors day on which the parent or any authorised guardian can come and meet the wards. Authorised visitors will be issued visitors card without which meeting of any hosteller is not permitted.

ETIQUETTES OF SLEEP

Do miswak/brush your teeth before you sleep and perform wudu.



Clean the bed. Change clothes before you sleep.

Sleep early after Isha prayer. Say dua before you sleep.

اللَّهُمَّ بِاسْمِكَ أَمُوتُ وَأَحْيَا



Sleep on your right side.
Never sleep on your stomach.

Wake up early and say dua

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ

Extend your greetings to every one. Do miswak/brush your teeth and perform wudu pray Fajr namaz with jamat.



ETIQUETTES OF EATING FOOD

Wash your hands before eating and do not wipe them.



Spread a mat, sit down and say Bismillah and start eating from what is near you, using your right hand.

Do not start eating before your elders. Pick up the food that has fallen down, clean it and eat.

Do not find faults with your food.

Chew your food properly and eat slowly. Use your fingers to eat and lick your fingers after finishing your food. Wash your hands, rinse and say the dua for finishing the food.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنَا وَسَقَانَا وَجَعَلَنَا مِنَ الْمُسْلِمِينَ ○

Sit, see, say Bismillah and drink water in 3 gulps

Do not breathe in the glass.

Say Alhamdulillah after you drink.

Do not blow on articles of food.



ETIQUETTES OF JOURNEY

Start your journey by saying 'Bismillah' and use your right foot to get into the bus. Be the first one to extend your greeting to fellow brothers / sisters.



Do not peep out of the bus nor push one another in the bus.

Try to maintain cleanliness inside and outside the bus.



Walk at a medium pace and help the people who are in need of directions.

ETIQUETTES AT SCHOOL

Enter the school peacefully and convey salam while entering your class.



Do not make noise in the classroom.
Respect your teachers and books.
Do not cause any harm to the classroom property.

Be careful while playing in the ground and do not push one another. Do not harm anyone with your hand or tongue. Remove harmful things from the pathways.
